MEETING APRIL 6, 2026

Meeting opened at 6:00 PM by Council President William Dunchuck at the Nanty Glo Borough municipal office.

Pledge of Allegiance given, moment of silence observed

- MOTION: Markovich, 2nd Lytle to approve the March 2, 2026 meeting minutes. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: DiPaolo, 2nd Lytle to accept the March 25, 2026 workshop notes. All ayes motion carried
- Public Comment:
- John Capelli was present to find out what property maintenance issues have been addressed concerning his neighbors.
- Mayor Ray gave his report:
- The USDA is spraying the goose eggs. The goose numbers have been going down
- The issue with ATVs from last month has settled down since the police spoke with the parents of the ATV riders.
- He also requested that council consider raising the cost of parking violations up to \$25.00. This can be done with the recodification of the ordinances
- The police handled 68 calls and collected \$965.92 in fines and fees.
- Mayor Ray would like to schedule a community town hall meeting at the fire hall to allow businesses and residents to share ideas on how the borough can improve. He wants to see how the borough feels about allowing ATVs on the borough roads also.
- Mayor Ray commented that there have been issues with vehicles parking too close to intersections and blocking the line of sight. He will have the police department investigate.

- Dunchuck gave an update on property maintenance issues in the borough; There are two properties on Bloom Avenue that the police department is investigating.
- MOTION: Markovich, 2nd DiPaolo to approve the GFT Infrastructure, Inc. Service Authorization Agreement No. 1 dated April 6, 2026: GFT will complete a preliminary design and construction cost estimate for the dredging of the reservoir located in Borough Park and various improvements throughout the park. GFT will also assist the borough with the completion of grant applications for the project. Total payment to GFT Infrastructure, Inc. for service authorization No. 1 will not exceed \$26,500.00. - MOTION: DiPaolo, 2nd McEvoy to award Contract No. 2026-1 Levee System Rehabilitation Project to Snyder Excavating, LLC of Johnstown, PA at their bid price of \$44,800.00. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: Markovich, 2nd McEvoy to authorize Stiffler McGraw Engineers to forward the contract agreement and other necessary documents to Snyder Excavating for execution and for the Nanty Glo Borough to execute the documents when they are returned from Snyder Excavating. All ayes motion carried

- MOTION: Markovich, 2nd Lytle to approve authorizing the Cambria County Conservation and Recreation Authority to utilize the Nanty Glo Park and Pool as the location for the ribbon cutting ceremony for the final section of the C&I extension Ghost Town Trail Loop on Wednesday, April 22, 2026, at 12:30 P.M. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: DiPaolo, 2nd Markovich to approve the Community Service Agreement between Rual Community Assistance Partnership Solutions (RCAP) and Nanty Glo Borough to conduct a GPS inventory and design a GIS Map of the borough's storm water system at no cost. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: Markovich, McEvoy to advertise for three (3) part-time summer maintenance positions, with a deadline for applications of May 1, 2026. All ayes motion carried
