- Cindy Olstein suggested that the council consider purchasing a banner for “Buzz” Wagner who had lived in Nanty Glo.

- The police department will have extra coverage for the firemen’s gun raffle. A new cruiser was requested. \$904.91 in fines and fees were collected. The police responded to 71 incidents. The goose harassment is a work in progress. A new laser pointer is needed for the road crew because their current one is broken. A resident requested that the borough open a trail for ATVs where the borough is cutting timber. Dunchuck noted that there were a lot of unofficial trails in that area. Another resident had approached him about setting up a blessing box in town. He will tell them to come to a council meeting to give more detail.
