

# NANTY GLO BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING

FEBRUARY 2, 2026

Meeting opened at 6:00 PM by Council President William Dunchuck at the Nanty Glo Borough municipal office

Pledge of Allegiance given, moment of silence observed

Council members present: William Dunchuck, Dave DiPaolo, Diane Holby, Michaela Markovich, Bob McEvoy

Others present: Julie Pittman, Chief Mike Freiwald, Melissa Weekes

- MOTION: Markovich, 2<sup>nd</sup> McEvoy to approve the January 5, 2026 meeting minutes. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: DiPaolo, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to accept the January 28, 2026 workshop notes. All ayes motion carried
- No public was present
- In the absence of the mayor, Chief Freiwald gave council a brief report: The police department has been enforcing the winter parking ordinance and issuing tickets. Total fines and fees collected were \$569.56.
- MOTION: Markovich, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to accept the treasurer's report. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: Markovich, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to pay bills as presented. Lytle questioned what the YCG bill was. Freiwald explained that it was for police equipment calibration. All ayes motion carried
- There was no property maintenance report or municipal authority financial report.
- All the documents for the Ameriserv business card were sent in. Ameriserv will be call and asked what the status of the application is.
- The proposed updated Comcast agreement will be emailed to the council members
- MOTION: Markovich, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to approve the Levee System Improvements Plan Set for Project Contract No. 2026-1. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: McEvoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to Motion to approve the following schedule for the Levee System Improvements Project Contract No. 2026-1:
  - Bid Advertising Dates for the project: February 11th and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
  - Bid Opening on March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. at the Borough Office.
  - Award Bids at the April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026, Borough Council Meeting.
  - Project Work to begin in May 2026, with completion date 60 days after. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: DiPaolo, 2<sup>nd</sup> McEvoy to approve the Cooperative Service Agreement between the Borough of Nanty Glo and the United States Department of Agriculture Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) Wildlife Services (WS) in the amount not to exceed \$5,712.07 for integrated Pest Management for Canada Geese. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: McEvoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby Motion to advertise for letters of interest for (3) three Nanty Glo Municipal Authority board member vacancies. All ayes motion carried
- Holby commented that she had checked at Ameriserv for authorized signers on the Beautification Committee account and if any changes or additions are made, then new signature cards will be needed for all signers.
- Holby also mentioned that she would like to invite the Fire ladies and Bryant Greene to the borough's next workshop to discuss ideas for the country's 250-year celebration

- MOTION: McEvoy, 2<sup>nd</sup> Holby to exit executive session at 6:43 PM. All ayes motion carried
- MOTION: Holby, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dunchuck to give Weekes a \$1.00 per hour raise retroactive to January 1, 2026 and to increase Beverly Zamboni to \$30.00 per week for cleaning, retroactive to January 1, 2026. All ayes motion carried
